APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AS A TRADE MARKS ATTORNEY

To the Designated Manager,

I, , hereby apply for registration as a trade marks attorney in accordance with the provisions of regulation 20.2 of the *Trade Marks Regulations 1995*.

- (1) I attach the following evidence that I have met the registration requirements under regulation 20.3 of the *Trade Marks Regulations 1995*:
 - a. evidence that the Board is satisfied that I have, or am entitled to the award of, an academic qualification of a kind mentioned in regulation 20.6;
 - b. evidence that the Board is satisfied that I have the knowledge of intellectual property law and practice (reg. 20.8) that is required for a person to practise as a trade marks attorney;
 - c. a declaration, that (i) I have not in the 5 years preceding the application, committed an offence prescribed by subregulation 20.10(1) of the *Trade Marks Regulations 1995*; and (ii) I am not under sentence of imprisonment for an offence prescribed by subregulation 20.10(2) of the *Trade Marks Regulations 1995*;
 - d. a declaration, by another person, that I am of good fame, integrity and character.
- (2) A declaration under paragraph (1) (d) must contain details of the basis of the opinion that the applicant is of good fame, integrity and character.
- (3) The prescribed fee of **\$250.00** is attached (set out in item 28 of Schedule 9 to the *Trade Marks Regulations 1995*)
