**PATENT ATTORNEY REGISTRATION UNDER THE TRANS-TASMAN REGIME**

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To the Designated Manager,

I, , hereby apply for registration as a patent attorney in accordance with the provisions of regulation 23.41 of the *Patents Regulations 1991*.

- (1) I attach the following evidence under subregulation 23.41(3) of the *Patents Regulations 1991*:
  - a. one or more statements of skill, for the purposes of regulation 20.11;
  - b. a declaration stating that (i) I have not, in the 5 years preceding the application, committed an offence prescribed by subregulation 20.12(1) of the *Patents Regulations 1991*; and (ii) I am not under sentence of imprisonment for an offence prescribed by subregulation 20.12 (2) of the *Patents Regulations 1991*;
  - c. a declaration, by another person, that I am of good fame, integrity and character.
  - d. a declaration that I satisfy the requirements mentioned in subregulation 23.41(1) of the *Patents Regulations 1991*:
- (2) A declaration under paragraph (1) (c) must contain details of the basis of the opinion that the applicant is of good fame, integrity and character.
- (3) The prescribed fee of **\$300.00** is attached (set out in item 104 of Schedule 7)
